Changes to the Canadian *Patent Act* and *Rules* IN FORCE: 30 October 2019

1) PCT National Phase Entry Deadlines

Requirements for Obtaining Valid Priority Date	Request priority, indicating the filing date, country of filing and application number of previously filed application(s).	 Request priority, indicating the filing date, country or office of filing and application number of previously filed application(s). <u>Additional requirement</u>² to either: a) submit a certified copy of the priority application with the Office; or b) make available a copy of the priority application in a digital library and inform the Office of the availability.³

³Presently, the Office has not indicated which digital libraries will be accepted.

** Restoration of Priority: For applications filed on or after 30 October 2019, it may be possible to request "restoration" of priority to an earlier application filed within the preceding fourteen (14) months. A request for restoration of priority must include a statement indicating that the failure to file the application within twelve (12) months was "unintentional".⁴




Scenario A

5-Year Examination Deadline Missed before 30 October 2019





5-Year Examination Deadline Missed <u>on or after</u> 30 October 2019 & <u>timely</u> Notice:





5-Year Examination Deadline Missed <u>on or after</u> 30 October 2019 & <u>late</u> Notice:




Scenario A


4-Year Examination Deadline Missed and late Notice






